Who we are

The UK's largest pension scheme by assets,


with £82 bn under management, dedicated to providing retirement benefits to over 470,000 members across more than 330 institutions in the higher education sector.

Established in 1974,

a not-for-profit corporate trustee responsible for administering a hybrid Scheme offering both defined benefit (DB) and defined contribution (DC) elements, supported by c.250 London-based and c.290-Liverpoool based staff. USS paid out over £2 bn in benefits during the period to 31 March 2021.

USS Investment Management,

established in 2012, is a dedicated in-house investment team managing nearly 70% of USS's assets including £23 bn in private market investments such as £4.3 bn in property and £1.2 bn in green technologies.


